Cor de la Bryère, with his pedigree of royal beginnings is the stallion that revolutionized sport and jumping horse breeding.

C.D. has an uncanny representation with his noble looks and outstanding frame, to his great grandfather Cor de la Bryère, who almost never made it to the breeding barn. In 1970, the selection committee of the Haras du Pin visited his owner, Xavier Ribard and suggested 'that he is not breeding stock and should be gelded.' His Dam, Famousgirl II, also has impressive and explosive lineage.
